Assistant Chief Power Engineer

Reporting to the Chief Power Engineer, the Assistant Chief Power Engineer is responsible for leading the coordination of all maintenance activities required in the Department. Working under broad guidelines, the Assistant Chief Power Engineer ensures adequate and timely maintenance is undertaken leading to high equipment reliability and operational availability.

Primary Responsibilities

- The Position will be responsible for production, quality, maintenance coordination, environmental compliance, and safety for the complete power and recovery area. This includes Incoming water and boiler water treatment, Effluent water Treatment, bark boiler, recovery boiler, Recast & Kiln, Steam Turbine, evaporators, and water, air, NCG and steam systems.
- Assumes the position and role of chief power engineer in their absence.
- Leads or facilitates problem solving meetings to investigate deviations from safety, quality and reliability targets, and executing the timely implementation of action plans to prevent future deviations
- Initiating work orders and purchase requisitions to mobilize the work and services needed.
- Maintains plant operating instructions and ensuring KPIs are properly communicated, tracked, and delivered against.
- Ensures all company standards, practices and procedures are followed.
- Monitors employee performance, development, training and succession planning.
- Networks and actively seeks help from available company resources.
- Annual and monthly Shut planning of Utilities area
- Responsible for coordination of maintenance activities between the operating group and maintenance.
- Work with area maintenance to lead implementation of Asset Reliability Program.
- Working with maintenance on Preventive and Predictive maintenance
- Coordinate the operator training program.
- Assist in managing the operations and maintenance budget for the Power & Recovery department.
