



CORPORATE DONATIONS POLICY

Northern Pulp is committed to participating in our community at the local and provincial level. The donations and sponsorships budget is established annually as part of the company's business and community engagement plan process.

WE CONSIDER:

- Projects, programs and organizations that align with company and employee community interests
- Organizations or events that give athletic, cultural and academic teams the opportunity to participate in qualifying competitions for national or international championships

WE DO NOT CONSIDER:

- Individual pursuits
- Religious organizations, with the exception of secular activities open to those of all faiths, such as operating a shelter or group program, or unless the organization is engaged in a significant project which benefits the entire community
- Donations to political or advocacy groups
- Donations to groups whose operating areas are outside of Canada

Requests shall be reviewed according to the criteria and guidelines set forth within this policy. Donations and sponsorships are not automatically renewed.

Requests can be made via a cover letter which includes a brief description of the organization's history, purpose and the scope of its activities; donation amount request; description of the proposal initiative and how the funds will be used and what the funding will accomplish, and the organization's charitable registration number, if applicable.
