

## EMPLOYEE DAUGHTERS AND SONS SCHOLASTIC AWARDS

---

### PURPOSE

The Northern Pulp employee daughters and sons scholastic awards have been established to recognize scholastic achievement and offset the cost of post-secondary education for deserving children of Northern Pulp Nova Scotia Corporation mill and woodlands employees. Scholastic awards are valued at \$1,000. Up to five scholastic awards may be awarded annually.

### ELIGIBILITY

All daughters and sons of regular, full time company employees are eligible to apply for a scholastic award. The scholastic awards will apply to any full time degree or diploma program taken at an accredited post-secondary university, college, technical training facility or community college. Both high school students entering one of these programs and students currently enrolled are eligible to apply. Awards will be presented to:

- Up to three students entering or currently enrolled in university or college studies
- Up to three students entering or currently enrolled in technical training facility or community college studies
- At least one high school graduate entering university, college, technical training facility or community college studies directly from high school
- Only one scholastic award may be granted to any individual student during their under graduate post-secondary years

Awards winners will be selected on the basis of effort in scholastic achievement along with involvement in school and community activities.

Applicants are required to:

1. Complete a scholastic award application form
  2. Enclose an official transcript of most recent grades
  3. Enclose two letters of reference
  4. Verify acceptance at a university, college, community college or technical school for the upcoming academic year
  5. Enclose an essay, up to 500 words, explaining why they feel they should be considered for this award.
